A Few Reminders for Communion

As you know, last weekend we resumed the practice of offering Holy Communion under both species. For the most part, everything went very well! Thanks for your help and patience as we slowly get back into practice.

A few important reminders: (1) For those of you who need assistance to receive Communion, simply stay in place and a Minister of Communion will come to you. We promise to do our best to get Holy Communion to everyone who wishes to receive it in a timely manner. (2) Please also remember that "intinction," or the practice of dipping the Body of Christ into the Blood of Christ before consuming it is not permitted. Everyone should consume the Body of Christ immediately after receiving it and should consume the Blood of Christ directly from the chalice (if you wish to receive under both species). (3) And, if you are sick, please refrain from receiving the Precious Blood.

Thanks for your help as we follow these guidelines, both out of respect and reverence for Jesus present in the Holy Eucharist and for the safety and care of each other.
