A Few Simple Notes from the Director

Divine Mercy Image

As you may recall, the Divine Mercy image in the Saints' Grotto was desecrated back in January, leading to an investigation, an arrest, and a three-month-long process of getting it restored. Within days of the incident, we discovered that the picture itself – originally from the Divine Mercy Shrine in Poland – was damaged beyond repair. So after a few quick lessons in Polish, I sent a note to the nuns who run the Shrine, explained our situation, and asked for their help to order a new image. They were wonderfully accommodating, even helping us ascertain a custom size and translating the inscription from Polish to English. Last week, we finally received the new image, and it does not disappoint! Within minutes of receiving it in the mail, I drove to the frame store and placed the order for new glass and proper stretching of the canvas. The image is supposed to be ready within the next few days!

Thanks to the generosity of Maria Tamburrino, her son Mario, and their entire family, the cost of the new print, the new glass, and the restoration of the frame have been completely covered! Their devotion to the Shrine and the image of Divine Mercy is nothing short of inspiring!

Our intention is to hang the image back in the grotto as soon as it is ready. In April, however, on Divine Mercy Sunday, we will not only rededicate the image, but we will have a special blessing of the entire Saints' Grotto to honor all the work that's been done in that space over the past year. I am grateful for your continued patience and prayers as we navigate this unexpected situation.

A Marathon of Mercy

I spoke to a man last week who decided to go back to Confession after 27 years. He goes to Mass a few times every week and never misses a Sunday. He is a Knight of Columbus and attends Stations of the Cross during Lent. He enjoys spiritual reading and encourages his kids to do the same. When I asked why he decided to go after 27 years, he said it just felt like the right time.

Whether it's been a few days or more than a few years, I invite you to join us next Saturday, March 16, 2024, between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We will have six priests (a new priest every two hours) to hear Confessions and serve as conduits of God's mercy and love. I hope you will join us! Let nothing be an obstacle to experiencing the mercy and love of God in your life. Sometimes, life just passes us by, and we need a little bit of encouragement to get back to the basics. I hope this invitation will serve as that encouragement for you... it might just be the right time! Saint Rita, generous in forgiving, pray for us!

You're invited to join us **every Thursday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:45 p.m.** for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Whether you stay for a few moments, or you commit to a full hour, please prayerfully consider stopping by the Lower Shrine Chapel.
