Join us for the Sacred Paschal Triduum

As you already know, the Catholic Church is about to embark on the holiest, most profound week of its liturgical year. And even though many of us are quick to limit our focus and reduce our energies to Easter Sunday alone, the Sacred Paschal Triduum, that is, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, offer us the richest celebrations of our faith, second to none. Why then, does it seem as though the Triduum remains one of the Church's best-kept secrets?

Maybe it's because they aren't Holy Days of Obligation? Maybe it's because they fall during the work week packed full of activities for the family? Maybe it's because three extra visits to church in the same week feels like a bit much? Whatever the reason, I want to assure you that the Triduum is worth the effort! Believe me. If you're waiting for a sign or an invitation, let this be it.

The Paschal Mystery is the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. From the Nativity to His public ministry, from the Last Supper to His passion and eventual death, from His Resurrection to His Ascension, we "know" all about Jesus, and yet we are left with a lot of questions. No matter how hard we try to piece together the parables taught or the final stations of His earthly life, our finite nature as human beings will never grasp the full story. We will never fully understand the joys and trials that Christ experienced, and yet He experienced them for us. To think that God became human so that He might be like us and ultimately, save us, is a gift.

So, please join us next week as we celebrate this gift, the central mystery of our faith, with deep intention and purpose. You won't be disappointed!
